biography

Formed in 2008 by three renowned and well know buskers Syd Greenfield (bass, vocals) , 'Canadian' David Headon (drums, vocals) and 'Little' Dave Manning (vocals, git). Canadian Dave had just landed in the country and was looking for a band to play with, whilst Little Dave and Syd had been friends for years and a chance meeting led to discussions about forming the band.

Syd moved on and was replaced by Tim Border (ex-Slowburner) on bass and they gigged local pubs and clubs until Canadian Dave extended his musical talents and moved on to his main instrument the electric Guitar. Ron Draper was recruited from The Big E Band on drums and with the addition of Nick Foley on Hammond Organ and Electric Piano the band had a clear idea about the type of music that they wished to play.

With a set of 60's tunes from artists such as Deep Purple, The Doors, the 13th Floor Elevators, The Nazz, Moby Grape, Spirit and Spencer David Group combined with original compositions they gigged extensively throughout the Midlands area. They have consistently pleased music lovers and venue owners alike with their ability to fill venues, keep people entertained, and hold the attention of passing trade for the entire evening!

The band are going strong and have a full complement of gigs already booked for this year, with only a few dates still available, and with your help are looking to take their music to larger venues next year.

technical specifications

We are a five piece band that require a minimum of approximately 20ft backline space to setup and perform in, anything less than this would need to be discussed but has been known. We have up to 1.8k portable Mackie/Warfedale PA rig (inc. monitors) with Behringer desk and 50ft multicore that we can also supply for smaller venues, along with 2 banks of 4 Par can lights on stands together with 2x4 sequential floor mounted lights and various 60's oil wheels (Opitikinetics) and peripheries.
